TICKETS - ADVANCE & DURING FEST

**TICKET PRICES ARE SUBJECT TO TICKET SYSTEM AND CONVENIENCE FEES

Advance ticket discounts available through Oct. 7, see website for details. After Oct 7th, tickets are still available online at the gate prices listed above.

Children under 12 admitted FREE when accompanied by a ticket-holding adult. **Teens age 12 - 17** are 50% off gate price. No one under 18 admitted without a parent/guardian.

Online ticket purchasers should present a printed copy of their ticket or order ID# upon arrival at the ticket booth to obtain wristband(s).

Photo ID and order ID# required for all will call orders.

No refunds or exchanges on tickets for any reason.

GATE HOURS

Early camping begins Oct 3rd. Camping fees apply; see website for details. During the Festival, campground gates are open 24 hrs/day for patrons wearing valid wristbands. Ticket booth hours are 9 a.m. until 10 p.m. daily. Kennedy Theater (including Food Pavilion & Craft Village) open from 6 p.m. until the concert concludes on each of the weekend nights listed above, typically around midnight. Kennedy Theater (including Food Pavilion & Craft Village) will also open 12 p.m. – 3 p.m. in the mid-week, with concerts from 12:30 p.m.- 2:30 p.m.

CAMPING (more details online)

ELECTRICITY is available throughout the campground on a first come, first serve basis and requires a paid permit, available in the campground beginning Oct. 3rd. WATER spigots are located throughout the campground, available for free if a hose-splitter is provided. HOT SHOWERS are free. A free "Kerrytes Kart" transports patrons around the Festival grounds.

PARKING

in the parking lot is free. **Campground Parking Permits** are \$25/day and required for any transportation vehicle to be parked in the campground; permits are available at the main ticket booth. Refundable two-hour **Campground Unloading Permits** are available at the campground gate for \$25. **Sleeper Vehicle Permits** are available at the campground gate for a single \$25 fee, provided the vehicle doesn't leave the campgrounds; a \$25 re-entry fee applies. (Sleeper Vehicles are pick-ups with camper shells, vans, pop-ups, trailers, and RVs without a reserved RV site. Passenger vehicles and towing vehicles ARE NOT considered Sleeper Vehicles and require a Campground Parking Permit to remain in the campground.)

RVs Reserved RV spaces typically have a waiting list. Large RVs without a reserved space may park in Overflow Parking with the purchase of a single Sleeper Vehicle Permit, available at the campground gate. See website for more details.
