**Children/Teen Prices** – Children under 12 admitted FREE when accompanied by a ticket-holding adult. **Tickets for ages 12 - 17 are 50% off gate price.** No one under 18 admitted w/o parent/guardian.

**TICKETS AND WRISTBANDS**  
 Online ticket purchasers should either print their tickets at the completion of the order or write down the "Order ID" number. Present the printed ticket(s) or Order ID # upon arrival at the Ticket Booth to pick up wristband(s). **Photo ID and Order ID # required for all Will Call pick-ups.** All attendees will be provided wristbands.

**CAMPING AND GATE HOURS**  
 Early camping starts on May . Camping fees apply for pre-fest days. Land Rush will take place at 4 p.m. on Saturday, May . See website or call the office for details. During the Festival, campground gates are open 24 hours for those wearing valid wristbands. Ticket booth hours are 9 a.m. until 10 p.m. daily. Kennedy Theater gates open from 6 p.m. until concert concludes on each of the weekend nights listed above.

**VEHICLES IN THE CAMPGROUNDS**  
 Our goal is to maximize tent & camping space by restricting cars and other vehicles in the campgrounds. For this reason, there is a **\$25 per day charge for personal transportation vehicles to remain in the campground.** However, refundable two-hour unloading permits are available at the campground gate for \$25.

**SLEEPER VEHICLES**  
 "Sleeper Vehicles" are pick-ups with camper shells, vans, pop-ups, trailers, and RVs not in a reserved space (passenger vehicles ARE NOT considered "sleeper vehicles"). Permits for Sleeper Vehicles are required and will be available at the campground gate for a single \$25 fee provided the vehicle doesn't leave the campgrounds. A \$25 re-entry fee applies. Towing Vehicles are not included with the Sleeper Vehicle permits and would require additional charge to remain in campgrounds.

**RV HOOK-UP SITES:** There are a limited number of RV hook-up sites on the ranch, however none are available at the time of this publication.

**CAMPGROUND ELECTRICAL PERMITS:** There are numerous free-standing electric plugs throughout the campground which are available on a first come, first served basis and require a paid permit. Permits can be purchased at the Crossroads Electrical booth for \$6 per day for 15-AMP, \$11 per day for 15-AMP (if running AC), or \$18 per day for 30-AMP.

**OVERFLOW PARKING FOR RVs:** If you have a large RV and don't have a site reservation for it, you may park in a designated area of the overflow parking lot across the street. There aren't hook-ups in this area, but you may use generators (in this area only). You may call the Festival Office to reserve an RV slot in the overflow parking lot. A \$25 Sleeper Vehicle Pass will be required to park an RV in the overflow lot and can be purchased at the campground gate.
